We would like to invite you to serve as a program committee (PC) member for the 2014 IEEE International Conference on Big Data, which will take place on October 27-30, 2014 in Washington, D.C.

This conference is emerging as the premier venue for publications on "big data" in all its various aspects. For last year's conference, we received 259 paper submissions for the main conference and 32 paper submissions for the industry and government program. Of those, 44 regular papers and 53 short papers were accepted, which translates into a selectivity that is on-par with top tier conferences.

Here are some details of what's involved, which is similar to the responsibilities of a PC member at other conferences: After the paper submission deadline, you will bid for papers to review, write the reviews, and then participate in an online discussion with members of the Senior Program Committee (SPC) to converge on a final recommendation. We are aiming for a reviewing load of 6-8 papers and we will strive for a reasonable workload of not more than ten papers. At the same time, we expect constructive and substantial reviews from PC members.

The deadlines are as follow:

Paper submission deadline: July 1, 2014

Paper review deadline: August 10, 2014

Discussion period: August 11-24, 2014

Notification of acceptance: September 1, 2014
