Dear Colleagues,

Thank you again for serving on the program committee of the research track of SIGKDD 2021.

Here are the next steps:

1. Make sure you update your profile in Toronto Paper Matching System (TPMS) as soon as possible and before bidding starts as that will be used by CMT for assignments.

2. Bidding will start on Feb 12th at 1 PM PT and end on Feb 17th at 11 PM PT. To bid log into: <https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/KDD2021>

3. Bidding is carried out by logging into CMT and selecting the "Reviewer" instead of the "Author" role.

4. While bidding, please sort papers in either ascending order by TPMS (it is a rank) or descending order by CMT relevance (it is a score).

5. Please bid for at least twenty papers with either rating "In a Pinch", "Eager" or "Willing." Please select "Not Willing" appropriately but sparingly as that reduces options for CMT.

6. Modulo expertise, when bidding please be biased towards "coverage" rather than just "interest" as we need reviews for all papers.

7. We request that you immediately scan the papers as soon as they are assigned to confirm if papers are following basic guidelines of paper length and anonymity.

8. Reviews are due on April 5th by 1 PM PT and we urge not wait till the last minute to complete the reviews.

9. We will be periodically sending emails to encourage reviewers to start the review process and we apologize in advance for those emails.
