


2 → Semantic fields of the surrounding vocabulary


We classified the surrounding vocabulary according to categories (from the tool Empath) that represent the following semantic fields:

government, internet, journalism, leader, negative emotion, politics, social media, technology

E.g.: internet \rightarrow homepage, download, hacker + 76 words journalism \rightarrow report, article, newspaper + 66 words









Before: "fake news" more mentioned with terms related to the **environment** where they occur (Internet, newspapers etc.)

After: "fake news" more mentioned with terms more close to the **content of the news themselves** (politics, elections etc.).



3 → Co-occurrence **networks**




4 → **Topics** addressed

Topics obtained with latent Dirichlet allocation (LDA)


Before the 2016 US election: less cohesive topics, but most are related to **Internet** and to the **spread of misinformation**, **in all regions**

After the 2016 US election: a relevant frequency of words related to **politics and online social networks** in the main topics
